Terms & Conditions

- 1.** Applications are subject to approval by Jac of All Markets. Submission of this form does not guarantee a stall site or a particular position.
- 2.** Market trading hours are 10:00am–2:00pm. Stallholders must be fully set up before opening and must not pack down or move vehicles through patron areas before 2:00pm unless authorised by the organiser or required for safety.
- 3.** Stallholders must follow bump-in, bump-out, parking, site allocation and emergency-access directions issued for each venue.
- 4.** Stallholders are responsible for the safety, stability and security of their own gazebo, marquee, umbrella, tables, racks, signage, stock and equipment. Suitable weights/anchoring must be used.
- 5.** All goods, displays, ropes, weights, cords, boxes and equipment must remain within the allocated footprint and must not obstruct aisles, exits, accessible routes, fire equipment or emergency access.
- 6.** Electrical equipment, extension leads, generators, LPG, cooking equipment and naked flames must be declared where relevant, maintained in safe condition and used only as approved. Appropriate fire-safety equipment must be available where required.
- 7.** Food vendors must hold all permits, registrations and approvals required by the relevant council/local government and any other authority. Food vendors are responsible for safe food handling, temperature control, hygiene, allergen information, potable water and lawful wastewater/grey-water disposal.
- 8.** Stallholders must hold current insurance appropriate to their activity and provide evidence when requested by Jac of All Markets, the venue or relevant authority.
- 9.** Stallholders are responsible for their own property, stock, cash, vehicles and equipment. Jac of All Markets is not responsible for loss, theft or damage except to the extent liability cannot lawfully be excluded.
- 10.** Stallholders must keep their site clean, manage waste responsibly and remove all rubbish, packaging, food waste and other items at the end of the market.
- 11.** Stallholders must behave respectfully toward organisers, other stallholders, venue staff and the public. Unsafe, unlawful, aggressive, discriminatory or seriously disruptive conduct may result in removal from the market.
- 12.** The organiser may require an unsafe activity or setup to be corrected, suspended or ceased. Stallholders must immediately follow reasonable safety and emergency directions.
- 13.** Market operation may be changed, postponed, relocated or cancelled due to weather, fire danger, venue requirements, emergency conditions, authority directions or other circumstances affecting safe operation. Any fee/credit arrangements will be communicated for the relevant market.

14. Stallholders must promptly notify Jac of All Markets of any incident, injury, near miss, property damage, food-safety issue or other significant safety concern occurring in connection with their stall.

15. Stallholders must advise Jac of All Markets if the information supplied in this application changes, including insurance, permits, stall dimensions, products, power, LPG or cooking arrangements.
